


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Kessler Kudos: New Student Fall Survey

Challenges to Student Sense of Belonging

Student concerns:

- Increased levels of anxiety or stress as academic year unfolds
- Concerns about grades and academic standing
- Imposter phenomenon and feelings of inferiority
- Relationships that are strained, consuming, or lack substance
- Difficulty find connections; dealing with isolation and loneliness
- Time management and competing priorities
- Strained family connections
- Financial challenges
- Pressure to secure internships or jobs

Students may be reluctant to ask for help or recognize they need assistance.

Our response: You belong. You can succeed. You can thrive here!

Lessons Learned

Strategies to Reinforce Belonging and Help-Seeking

- Connect students with individuals who understand their experiences
- Offer counter-narratives to reinforce you belong and can succeed here
- Intervene through curricular and co-curricular engagement:
 - Construct relevant service projects for students to give back
 - > Create time for students to share and learn from each other
 - Review data to identify equity gaps in engagement and support
- Guide students to resources that are easily available, accessible, and free
- Be explicit about how privilege operates and seek ways to disrupt
